


## NOTICE

### Subject: Holidays for Shab-e-Qadr, Jumatul Widha, Eid-ul-Fitr and Independence Day 2026 and Operational Plan for Different Activities

In accordance with the approval of the Management Authority and the Government-declared holidays on the occasion of Shab-e-Qadr, Jumatul Widha, and Eid-ul-Fitr, the following holiday and academic operation plan of Green University of Bangladesh is notified for the information of all faculty members, administrative staff and students of the university:

Dates and Days	Activities	Remarks
14–16 March (Saturday–Monday)	Online class and in-person Office	All classes will be conducted online. Faculty Members will share the respective class codes/links with the concerned Department Chairpersons and Departmental Coordination Officers (DCOs) in due course. The DCOs shall compile, and submit the class reports to the authority accordingly. However, Academic Administrators (Deans, Chairpersons, Controller of Exams, Proctor, Assistant Proctors, Directors, Additional Directors, Deputy Directors, Assistant Directors, Program Coordinators, Assistant Program Coordinators, and equivalent positions), Administrative Officers and Supporting Staff shall perform their office duties in person during these days.
17-23 March (Tuesday–Monday)	Holidays	The University will remain closed on 17 March and from 19 to 23 March on the occasions of Shab-e-Qadr, Jumatul Widha, and Eid-ul-Fitr. In addition, 18 March will be observed as a holiday by Executive Order to ensure continuity and consistency of the vacation period. However, emergency services, and essential maintenance activities (including security services, gardening and other support services) will remain operational as per university requirements.
24 and 25 March (Tuesday–Wednesday)	Online class and Office	All classes will be conducted online, and the Faculty Members as well as Administrative Staff will perform their offices online. However, the persons assigned for emergency services will perform their duties in-person.
26 March (Thursday)	Independence Day	The University will remain closed. A separate circular outlining the guidelines for observing the day with due respect and solemnity will be issued in due course.
27 March (Friday)	Usual Functioning of Offices and Classes	On 27 March 2026 (Friday), regular classes for selected programs and batches will resume in person as per the class routine. The relevant offices will be functional with a minimum workforce in line with the usual Friday practices.

The University will remain fully functional from 28 March 2026 (Saturday). All concerned are requested to take due note of the above and act accordingly to ensure uninterrupted academic and administrative operations.
